The Black River Jazz Orchestra received all First Division Ratings from all the judges at the MSBOA State Jazz Band Festival March 28, 2012. The clinician highly praised the students and used descriptions like "mature players" and "advanced program". A few of our students were nominated for the Michigan Youth Fine Arts Band that performs at a conference as well as the Detroit Jazz Festival.

From the Athletic Boosters:

"Under the lights, with that kind of a crowd, on that field - it was an awesome experience that I think people are going to remember for a long, long time!" That was what Coach Kyle Lawton had to say after the homecoming game win over Fennville at Hope College last October.

On Thursday, May 17, Coach Lawton will bring another team to the stadium with a similar goal in mind; a win over a highly ranked, out of conference opponent to get them ready for a deep run into the state tournament. The Black River girls varsity soccer team brings a young roster loaded with high caliber talent to the Van Andel Soccer Stadium. After starting the season 0-2, the girls rebounded by reeling off five straight wins including a dominating 4-0 performance against Zeeland East.

This game will be hard fought and competitive as Tri Unity has had success similar to Black River's in recent years.

The festivities kick off at 5:30p with a tail gate in the parking lot across the street from the stadium. Cost of tailgate is \$5 and includes your admission into the stadium for the big game! Stadium gates open at 6:20p for reserved seating and 6:30p for general admission with pregame ceremonies beginning at 6:50p and kick off at 7:00p.

Black River Athletic Passes will be honored for general admission as well as free entry for Black River students with student IDs. General admission for all other spectators is \$3. New this year is the opportunity to upgrade your general admission seat to a more comfortable reserved stadium seat (with back) for an additional \$3. Check out the seating chart and purchase reserved seats at the main office starting May 11th.

Make sure to come out on May 17 and join your Black River community in honoring the seniors and watching what is sure to be a close and competitive soccer game!
