- Instruction facilitated by BR Montessorians
- Support in creating flexible daily schedules
- Teacher/student commitment to daily, personal interactions
- Follow all required safety protocols, including face masks
- Curriculum crafted by our trained Montessori staff, with Montessori philosophy, current research, and child development as our foundation
- Focuses on hands-on experiences and off-line opportunities
- Frequent, intentional feedback from our teachers
- Individualized instruction and support of the whole child within a learning community
- Daily health surveys

- Classes taught by BR teachers that follow BR curriculum and pacing
- Consider having students bring their own personal technology devices to reduce the need for shared equipment
- Training in Google Classroom and other Google applications for learning management
- A block schedule TBD to minimize exposure
- Education responsibilities that continue for students during times of building closure
- Required student use of BRPS email for communications and application sign-ins
- A place for social, emotional and academic growth
- Following of all internet safety protocols
- Following all required safety protocols, including face masks

- Classes taught by BR teachers that follow remote BR curriculum and pacing with primarily asynchronous/ non-live teaching delivery
- Synchronous/live teaching sessions offered when feasible
- Training in Google Classroom and other Google applications for learning management
- Class materials and assessments provided via Google Classroom and other Google applications
- Regular teacher feedback via Google Classroom
- Regular attendance and work expected
- Required student use of BRPS email for communications and application sign-ins
- A place for social, emotional, and academic growth
- Following of all internet safety protocols
- Family coordination and encouragement at home required

\*NOTE: If we move into MI Safe Start: Phase 3, the in-person (Face-to-Face) instruction will revert to a remote learning plan for all BRPS students.
