In January 2015, the Michigan Department of Education announced that it adopted the redesigned SAT test as the new state test for all juniors. In order to help students prepare for this change, Black River is happy to provide the opportunity for juniors to take the PSAT (practice SAT) for free in October 2021. This year's test will take place at **First Reformed Church on Wednesday, October 13**. This testing is optional and we ask that students sign up no later than **Friday, September 10**.

ARRIVAL/DISMISSAL:

Student Check-in: **7:45am SHARP!**

Student Dismissal: **12:15pm (approximate end time)**

WHAT TO BRING:

#2 pencils, erasers, picture ID (in case you aren't recognized by testing staff), water/snack for break, approved calculator

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

Cell phone, electronics, or anything that can access the internet or create a disturbance.

TRANSPORTATION:

Students should be dropped off directly at First Reformed Church. Transportation back to school will not be provided.

LUNCH:

When testing concludes, students will be given 30 minutes for lunch. All students are encouraged to bring a sack lunch. Students will be expected to return to campus after testing.
